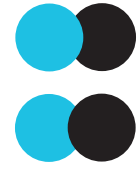

Arrange will move object from front to back and back to front.

- Group combines objects into one unit. The black arrow will select the entire group. The white arrow will select parts of a group.
- Lock freezes objects so that they cannot be selected. Locking individual objects can be done in layers or by using Command 2 on the keyboard. Holding the shift key selects multiple objects that can then have changes made to all that are selected. For example, they can be locked.



The Selection Tool or black arrow will select all parts.

The Direct Selection Tool or white arrow will select parts of an object such as a line in a square. Holding the option key while selecting with the white arrow will select all.
