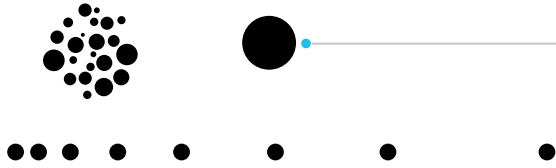


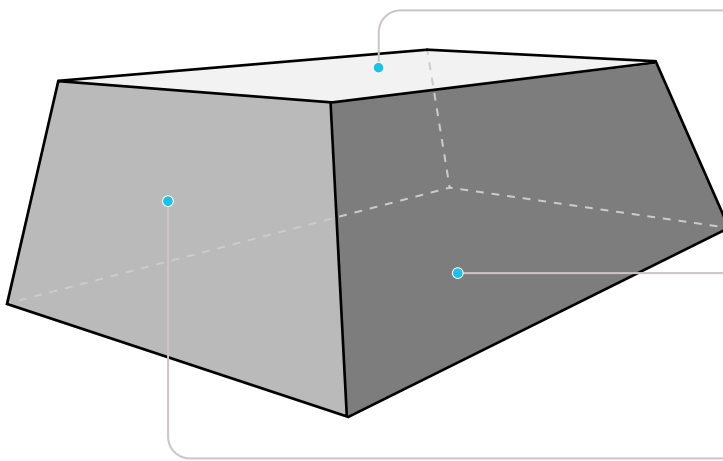
point & line to plane



• A point presents a small, brief element to the story that can add texture, focus and movement.



• A line can be straight, curved, zigzagged, diagonal, vertical, horizontal, spiral or more.



• A plane is a two-dimensional flat surface. The image shown to the left is a rectangular box in three-point perspective with 3 visible planes.

The light gray is the top plane.

• The darkest gray is the right plane.

• The medium gray is the left plane. Being able to find the planes in an object like a box or building is needed to determine perspective.
