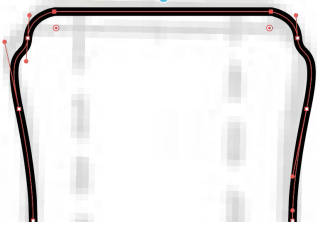
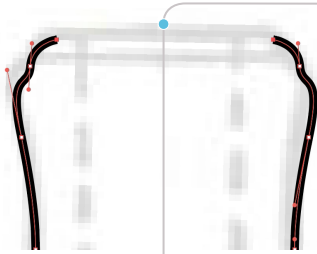
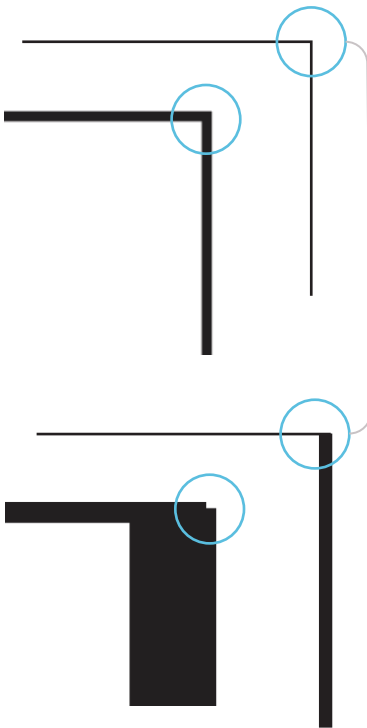
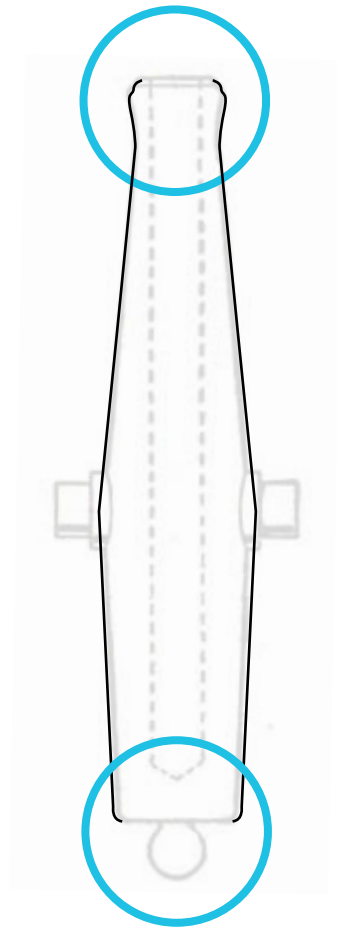


Join



Join (Command J) connects two paths or closes an open path. To join two points first select two anchor points and only two anchor points. Drag across both with the white arrow being careful to only select two anchor points or use the white arrow and the shift key to click on each anchor point. Then join with the Command J keyboard command.

Joining can also be done using the pen tool. Click the first anchor point and then move your cursor to the second anchor point and click.



When possible join corners or other connections for a cleaner more professional graphic. Strokes of different weights cannot be joined and must be overlapped. Judge the quality of the overlapping at actual size not when enlarged at hundreds of percent.
